Advice Letter No. 119A

**TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA:**

This Advice Letter supplements Advice Letter 119, submitted on February 26, 2016, by providing a proposed Protective Order to govern the confidential treatment of the Temporary Support Service Agreement for Internet Protocol (IP) Interconnection ("Agreement") submitted with the Advice Letter. By this supplemental advice letter, Frontier reiterates its request that the Agreement supplied pursuant to Advice Letter 119 be held as confidential in the Commission's files. This supplement to Advice Letter 119 provides a Protective Order and additional information in support of Frontier's confidentiality request. The proposed Protective Order is attached as Attachment A to this supplemental Advice Letter.

The Agreement accompanying Advice Letter 119 should be held under seal in the Commission's files, as the Agreement is a confidential document whose public disclosure would subject the signatories to the Agreement to an unfair business disadvantage, in contravention of General Order 66-C, Section 2.2(b). The Agreement is not publicly disclosed and is consistently held as confidential by the parties. It contains sensitive information reflecting the manner in which Frontier will arrange for and receive Session Initiation Protocol (SIP) carrier transiting and interconnect services from Verizon Business on a temporary basis for approximately one year or until the traffic for these five parties is transitioned directly to Frontier's network and systems. The Agreement should be held as confidential for at least three years.

Fully un-redacted copies of the Agreement have already been provided to the Commission. It may be possible to refer to summary or aggregated information regarding the Agreement, but Frontier would have to evaluate that possibility if it were requested. Frontier is willing to make the Agreement available to non-commercial parties, such as consumer groups, pursuant to a Non-Disclosure Agreement. No tariff sheets have been submitted with this supplemental advice letter. This supplemental filing will not increase any existing rate or service, result in the withdrawal of service, or conflict with any of Frontier's other schedules.

Copies of this supplemental Advice Letter are being served to interested parties requesting such notification. In addition, Frontier is sending an email copy of this supplemental advice letter to the service list for A.15-03-005.
