

ACCESS SERVICE

3. Carrier Common Line Access Service

Carrier Common Line Access Service will be offered by the Telephone Company in conjunction with either Telephone Company provided Switched Access Service or Switched Access Service provided by an Other Network Provider.

3.1 General Description

Carrier Common Line Access provides for the use of Telephone Company provided common lines by Customers for access to End Users to furnish Intrastate Communications.

3.2 Limitations

3.2.1 Exclusions

Neither a telephone number nor detail billing are provided with Carrier Common Line Access. Additionally, directory listings and intercept arrangements are not included in the rates and charges for Carrier Common Line Access.

3.2.2 Access Groups

All line side connections provided in the same access group will be limited to the same features and operating characteristics.

All trunk side connections provided in the same combined access group will be limited to the same features and operating characteristics.

3.3 Undertaking of the Telephone Company

3.3.1 Provision of Service

The Telephone Company will provide the use of Telephone Company common lines by a customer for access to end users at rates and charges as set forth in 3.7 following. The Telephone Company will also transport switched intrastate access messages to Other Network Provider common lines.

3.3.2 Interstate and Intrastate Use

The Switched Access Service provided by the Telephone Company includes the Switched Access Service provided for both interstate and intrastate communications. The Carrier Common Line Access rates and charges as set forth in 3.7 following apply to intrastate Switched Access Service access minutes in accordance with the rate regulations as set forth in 3.6 following.

3.4 Obligation of the Customer

3.4.1 Supervision

The customer facilities at the premises of the ordering customer shall provide the necessary on-hook and off-hook supervision. All Switched Access Service provided to the customer will be subject to Carrier Common Line Access charges.

3.4.2 When the customer reports interstate and intrastate use of Switched Access Service, the associated Carrier Common Line Access used by the customer for intrastate will be determined as set forth in 3.6.1 following.

3.4.3 Where Feature Group C end office switching is provided without Telephone Company recording and the IC records minutes of use which will be used to determine Carrier Common Line Access charges (i.e., Feature Group C operator and TSPS calls such as pay telephone sent-paid, operator-DDD, operator-person, collect, credit-card, third number and/or other like calls), the IC shall furnish such minutes of use detail to the Telephone Company in a timely manner. If the IC does not furnish the data to the Telephone Company, the IC shall identify all Switched Access Services which could carry such calls in order for the Telephone Company to accumulate the minutes of use through the use of special Telephone Company measuring and recording equipment.

3.5 Determination of Usage Subject to Carrier Common Line Access Charges

Except as set forth herein, Carrier Common Line Access charges shall apply to all Telephone Company provided common lines.

Carrier Common Line Service will be billed as set forth in 3.6.1, 3.6.2, following.

3.5.1 Determination of Jurisdiction

When the customer reports interstate and intrastate use of Switched Access Service, the associated Carrier Common Line Access used by the customer for interstate will be determined as set forth in 3.6.1 following (Percent Interstate Use-PIU).

3.5.2 Local Exchange Access and Enhanced Services Exemption

When access to the local exchange is required to provide a customer service (e.g., MTS/WATS-type, telex, Data, etc.) that uses a resold private line service, Switched Access Service Rates and Regulations, as set forth in Section 6 following will apply, except when such access to the local exchange is required for the provision of an enhanced service. Carrier Common Line Access rates and charges as set forth in 3.7 following apply.

3.6 Rate Regulations

3.6.1 Percent Interstate Use (PIU)

When the customer reports interstate and intrastate use of in-service Switched Access Service, Carrier Common Line charges will be billed only to intrastate Switched Access Service access minutes based on the data reported by the customer as set forth in 2.3.10 preceding (Jurisdictional Reports), except where the Telephone Company is billing according to actuals by jurisdiction. These reports will be used to determine Carrier Common Line charges based on the rates set forth in 3.7 following.

3.6.2 Unmeasured Feature Group A and B Usage

When Carrier Common Line Access is provided in association with Feature Group A or Feature Group B Switched Access Service in Telephone Company end offices that are not equipped for measurement capabilities or are provided by an Other Network Provider, an assumed average intrastate access minutes will be used to determine the Transitional (non-Premium) charges. The assumed average intrastate access minutes of use.
